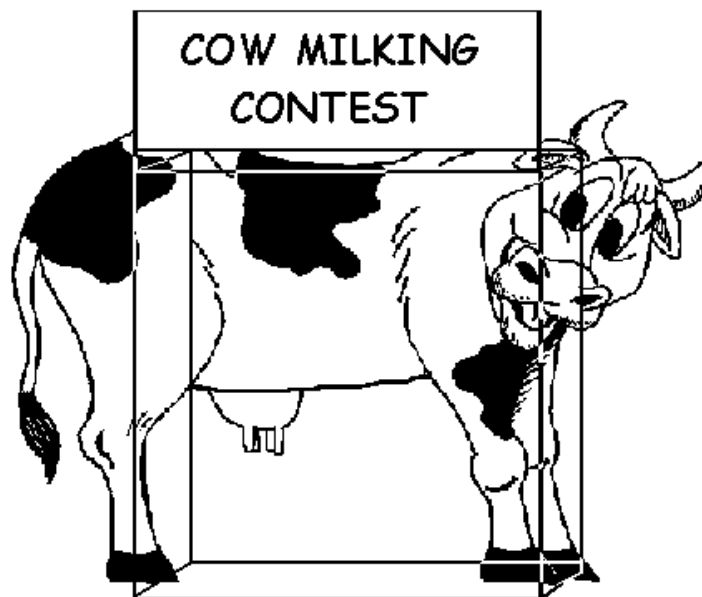

# ***COW MILKING CONTEST***

## ***Assembly Instructions***

- 1. Select a level area to operate the game with plenty of room to allow a line to form.***
- 2. Move cow into position.***
- 3. Insert the Bottom Supports into the bottom of the frame.***
- 4. Attach the side(s) using the bolts and wing-nuts.***
- 5. Put Udder Bucket into the space inside the frame.***
- 6. Insert the Banner Supports (lengths of tubing with welds) into the top of the frame.***
- 7. Slide pockets on either side of the banner(s) over the Banner Supports.***



# ***Safety Instructions***

- 1. If using game outdoors, it is strongly suggested that you use the stakes provided on either side of the bottom supports. Use sandbags on pavement. And in a breeze, use sandbags with the stakes.***
- 2. NEVER USE THE GAME IN STRONG WINDS OR LIGHTNING!***
