## Instruction Guide: Setting Up a Sound System

### Components

• Mixer: Peavey 10BT Mixer with Power Cord

• Cables: 7 XLR cables

• **Speakers**: 2 EV ZLX15P powered speakers (With power cords in side pocket)

• **Stands**: 2 speaker stands

• Microphone: 1 corded microphone

• DI Box: 1 Direct Input (DI) box & 1/8" to RCA Cable

## **Step 1: Position Your Equipment**

### 1. Locate a stable, central position for the mixer:

o Place it where it can be easily accessed during the event.

## 2. Set up the speaker stands:

- o Extend the legs evenly for stability.
- Adjust the height to match the venue's acoustics (ear level for the audience is ideal).

### 3. Mount the speakers:

o Secure each EV ZLX15P speaker on the stands.

# **Step 2: Connect the Mixer to the Speakers**

# 1. Use XLR cables:

 $_{\odot}$  Connect one end of an XLR cable to the  $\pmb{\mathsf{Main}}$   $\pmb{\mathsf{Out}}$  (L) on the Peavey 10BT Mixer.



o Plug the other end into the **Input (Channel 1)** of the first speaker. It may look like it won't fit but it will go into INPUT



o Repeat for the Main Out (R) on the mixer to the second speaker.

# 2. Check speaker input mode:

o On the EV ZLX15P speakers, set the input source to **Line** if required.

### **Step 3: Connect Audio Sources**

### Microphone

- 1. Plug the corded microphone into an XLR cable.
- 2. Connect the other end of the cable to a channel on the Peavey 10BT mixer (e.g., **Channel 1**).
- 3. Adjust the **Gain** knob for the channel to ensure a clean input signal. (Make sure it's not muted)

#### DI Box

- 1. Plug the instrument or audio source (e.g., laptop) into the input jack of the DI box.
- Use an XLR cable to connect the DI box output to a channel on the mixer. ONLY ONE CHANNEL NEEDED

#### **Bluetooth Device**

- 1. Turn on Bluetooth on your device (e.g., phone or tablet).
- 2. On the Peavey 10BT Mixer:
  - Press the Bluetooth Pair button.
  - The mixer's Bluetooth channel will appear on your device's pairing list. Enter Code 7878
- 3. Select the mixer from the list to pair your device.
- 4. Once connected, play audio from the device.
- 5. Use the **Bluetooth Channel Knob** to adjust the volume.

### Step 4: Power and Signal

### 1. Power the speakers:

- Connect the power cables to the EV ZLX15P speakers and a reliable power source.
- Turn on the speakers and set the volume knobs to a mid-level starting position.

#### 2. Power the mixer:

o Plug in the Peavey 10BT mixer and power it on.

# **Step 5: Adjust Mixer Settings**

- 1. Set levels: START ALL AT ZERO
  - Set main volume at Zero
  - o Gradually increase the **Selected Channel Knob** to test audio.



# 2. Balance inputs:

 Adjust individual channel levels for the microphone, DI box, and Bluetooth channel.

# 3. **EQ and effects**:

o Use the EQ controls to fine-tune the sound.

# Step 6: Test the System

# 1. Check each input:

 Test the microphone, DI box, and Bluetooth audio to ensure they work correctly.

### 2. Walk the room:

o Confirm even sound coverage and adjust speaker placement if needed.

## **Tips for Success**

- Keep cables organized to avoid tripping hazards.
- Use the DI box for balanced audio signals and to prevent unwanted noise.
- Monitor sound levels to prevent distortion or feedback.
